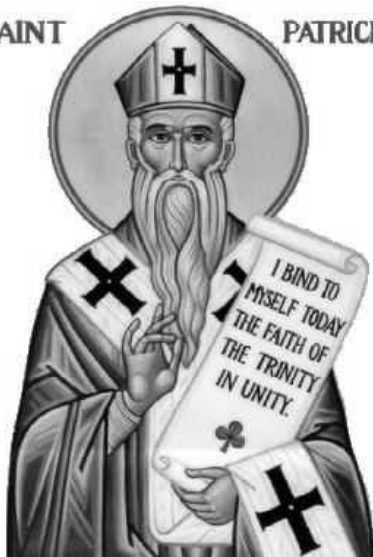

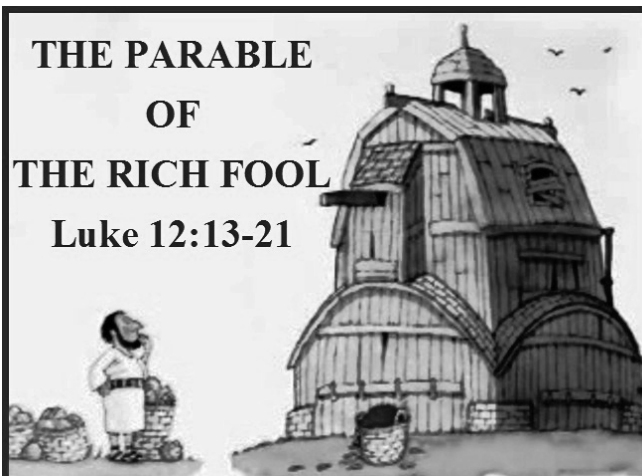

# OFFICE OF THE BISHOP

## DIOCESE OF MANCHESTER

Dear Brothers in Christ, Priests in Service of Our Lord Jesus Christ for the salvation of souls:

I send this letter after having celebrated the Sunday Liturgy. Having brought many intentions to that Liturgy, not least among them the current civil unrest in our country, the deaths of officers of Law Enforcement in Dallas, the recent sufferings of so many on Bastille Day in Nice, the attack on the airport and subsequent attempted coup in Turkey, the many who cry out in grief and mourning in our Country and throughout the world, and certainly those in the Middle East who have been relegated to the back pages of the news while their suffering nonetheless escalates daily, I came out of that Liturgy to be slammed with yet another atrocity, this time in Baton Rouge's streets and law enforcement community! Calamity in the streets and a seething of perverse evil is rampant and seeking more to devour.

I am calling on every Catholic in the Diocese of Manchester to engage in the coming act of solidarity in faith which you and I must engage in and provide for. We will not stand, but bow before God, in prayers and acts of atonement.

We will offer this act of solidarity in preparation for the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15 – celebrating a Dogma of Popular acclamation as the atrocities of the Second World War could not silence the need to heal and rebuild a broken world wherein Continents, house-holds, families and communities were divided and sorrows mounted. Therefore, I direct, in accordance with the teaching, governing and sanctifying office of the diocesan bishop that:

**Friday August 12, 2016 is to be a day of fast and partial abstinence (meat is eaten only once that day for all who are able and will not lightly excuse him or herself) in solidarity of faith for reparation** for the sins that have brought us to this deteriorating condition of war and civil unrest. These sins are many and personal and I ask everyone to join this communal penance to make amends and to pray for the conversion of hardened hearts.

### **Sunday August 14, 2016 The Twentieth Sunday of Ordinary Time**

Mass Prayers, Collect, Gifts, Post-Communion on this day are to be taken from The Masses For Various Needs and Occasions: *In Time of War or Civil Disturbance* Readings, however, are to be of the Sunday.

### **Monday August 15, 2016 The Solemnity of The Assumption of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary**

a) **Mass** is to be celebrated as if it were a holy day of obligation with highest solemnity; b) Provision is also to be made at some point during the day for **Exposition** of the Blessed Sacrament, c) and recitation of the Rosary (Luminous Mysteries).

I entrust this action of solidarity in faith for atonement, reparation and healing peace to you and your people in the sure and certain hope that God does not disappoint and will count this as a moment of blessing and deepest Mercy.

Let us therefore encourage one another in faith and let us gather our people in this moment as a visible sign of the Church, the Body of Christ in the world.
