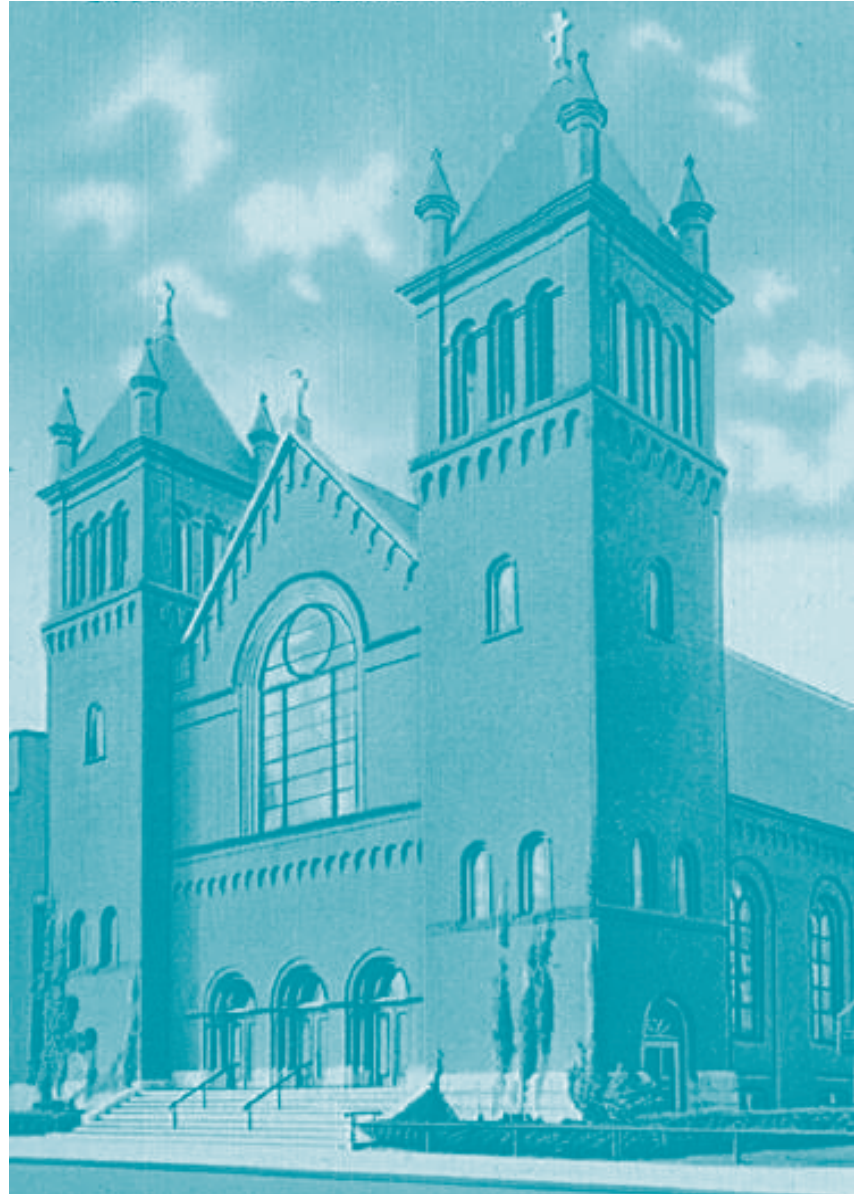

Next weekend we will hold our Annual Mission Appeal. Please welcome Rev. Albert A. Adélèké of Ijebu-Ode Diocese, Nigeria. Ijebu-Ode Diocese is located in the Western part of Nigeria, near Lagos. Ijebu-Ode Diocese is a rural but growing Diocese. The population is predominantly Muslim; with 50% Muslims, 25% Christians of other denominations, 15% Catholics and 10% Traditional African believers. The Diocese has 23 parishes with over 150 churches, 7 houses of formation, and 12 religious houses for male and female religious groups. The Catholic population does not have enough material and financial resources to sustain the many developing programs of evangelization, i.e. sustenance of priest and religious, training of seminarians, and to sustain primary health care projects for the villagers. Please be as generous as possible to Fr. Adélèké's Mission Diocese.

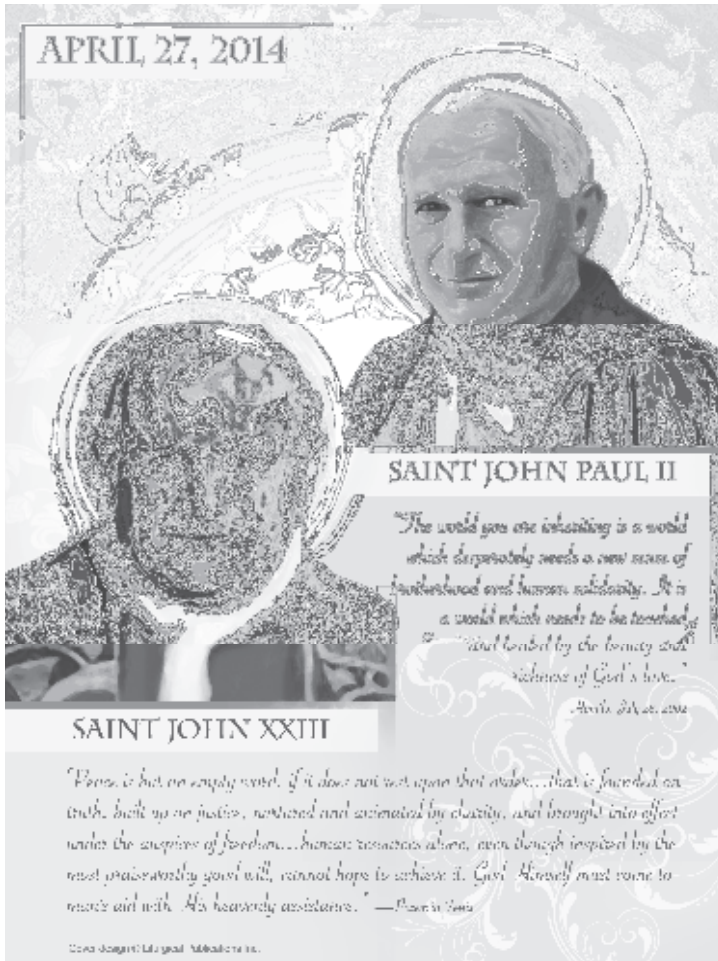

The Wounds of the Risen Christ

Sacred Scripture says almost nothing about the physical appearance of the Risen Christ except that His wounds remained clearly visible. We see this in two texts. First, when St. John describes the meeting between the Risen Christ and St. Thomas on the second Sunday after Easter, he notes: “Then (Jesus) said to Thomas, ‘Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side’” (John 20:27). Second, in St. Luke’s account of a later appearance to the disciples, he recalls that the Risen Christ introduced Himself this way: “He said to them, ‘Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? Look at my hand and feet; see that it is I myself. Touch me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have’” (Luke 24:39).

Considering that we believe that the human body in its “resurrected state” will be completely healed of all defects, perfected, and completely immune from all forms of suffering and subsequent death, it seems very strange that the hands, feet, and pierced side of the Risen Christ were not restored to their original condition. Why not?

The wounds of Christ remain forever to remind us of the inseparable connection between Good Friday and Easter Sunday. The Resurrection is not simply the miraculous resuscitation of the corpse of a man who died a peaceful death in old age. Not at all. The Resurrection is the glorious transformation of the Crucified One into the Risen One. Without the self-giving of Christ through the Cross, the Resurrection would accomplish nothing at all. As such, the visible wounds of the Risen Christ are not defects. Instead, they are His “trademarks” in that they perpetually remind us of His Crucifixion.

This helps us to understand the traditional Catholic preference for the crucifix with the image of the suffering Christ as opposed to the empty cross. In recent times, some have insisted that the crucifix should be removed during the Easter Season, claiming that it detracts from the proper celebration of the Resurrection. But that’s like saying that the Risen Christ should have worn gloves, socks, and a toga when appearing to the disciples and others lest they be traumatized anew by remembering Good Friday.

We are able to look at the crucifix only because we believe in Easter.
