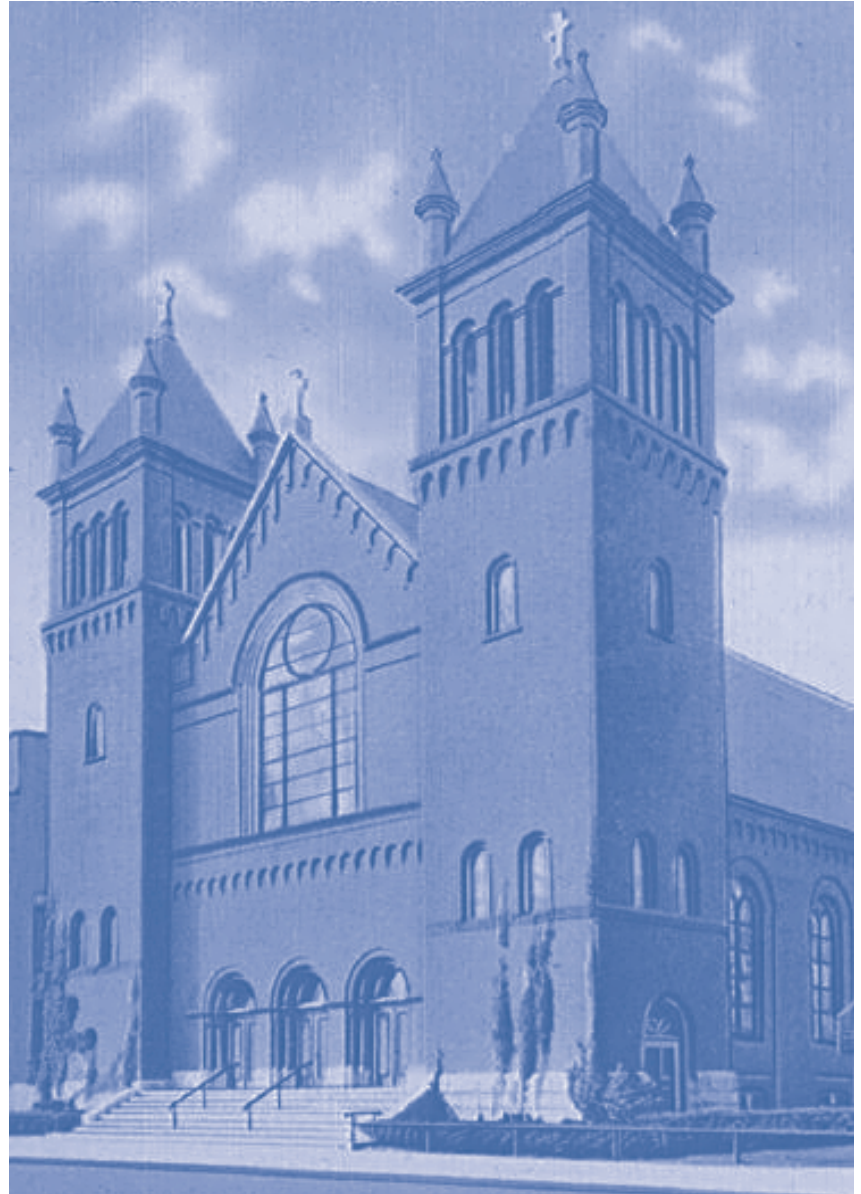

Nashua Soup Kitchen & Shelter, Inc.

The Nashua Soup Kitchen & Shelter provides extraordinary service to thousands each year. In recent years, it has seen its demand for services grow; it is giving out 36% more food than it did just two years ago.

This increase in demand has made its current, inadequate space simply unworkable. The organization has purchased and will renovate the former VFW Hall on Quincy Street. The building is three-times the size of the current space, and will allow NSKS to bring many of its programs under one roof, increase the number of people it serves, and offer greater dignity to those being served. It also maintains the organization's presence in Nashua's downtown.

To date the Nashua Soup Kitchen and Shelter has raised \$1.6 million of the \$2 million needed to conduct the renovations on the new building.

Two anonymous donors have made a challenge to the community: Give \$150,000 to the Nashua Soup Kitchen & Shelter by December 31, 2013 and they will match it with an additional \$100,000.

A Christmas Message from the Bishop

This Christmas let us make an especially reflective and prayerful visit to the Christmas Crib. Here we will see a remarkable sight. Whether its surroundings are a stable or a cave, it is the manger holding the Christ-Child that is the focal point. Mary and Joseph, the shepherds and the three kings draw us closer to that focal point as they, too, are seeing a most remarkable sight. A hovering angel is poised between heaven's starlit sky and earth's chosen spot, and the angel, too, draws our attention to the Christ-Child, the Holy Infant lying in a manger. How awesome is this place! The worldly comfort of an inn's warmth has been traded for a very different kind of warmth that reaches from earth to heaven and back again. It is a warmth that reaches across the ages and across the altar into the very deepest part of our heart's personal longing. "There was no room for them in the inn" the Gospel of Luke says, but there is room for them in the deepest part of your heart's longing if you are ready to welcome the Christ of Christmas.

He is the One who found His first welcome in an imperfect and broken place, but through that welcome He bestowed on that little home a radiance and a nobility that, to this day, makes us pause for a moment and give thanks. All He asks is a welcome and He will begin His transforming work in our souls.

This Season and, in fact, every life can have its share of fun, but at the same time life can be terribly busy and complicated and, for some of us, terribly painful. Like the stable where Jesus was born, maybe our own heart is not a perfect place, but the circumstances of Christ's birth remind us that even from imperfect beginnings great things can come. God can do great things through us, if only we make room in our hearts. But to welcome Him we need to make room for Him consciously in our hearts. Not a lot of room, but a small, sacred place where Jesus can be born. Here is where the Sacrament of Reconciliation – Sacramental Confession – clears just the right space. The sins we regret, the wrongs, the addictions, the things that we indulge in that lead to yet more disappointment for ourselves and others – these are the things that say to Our Lord, "I'm sorry, there is no room for you." Don't let a miracle be lost, a radiance be dimmed or a heart's truly longed-for Christmas Gift be misplaced!

If we make room for Christ this Christmas and welcome Our Lord into our hearts we can hear the Christmas Carols in a new way. Think about the words to "O Holy Night":

O Holy Night! The stars are brightly shining, It is the Night of the dear Savior's birth. Long lay the world in sin and error pining, Till He appeared and the soul felt its worth! A thrill of hope the weary world rejoices, For yonder breaks a new and glorious morn.

This is what Christmas promises: "To those who did accept Him He gave power to become children of God...And the Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us, and we saw His glory, the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth." (Jn1:12,14) My prayerful best wishes to you all for a blessed, holy, refreshing and merry Christmas in your home and in your heart.
