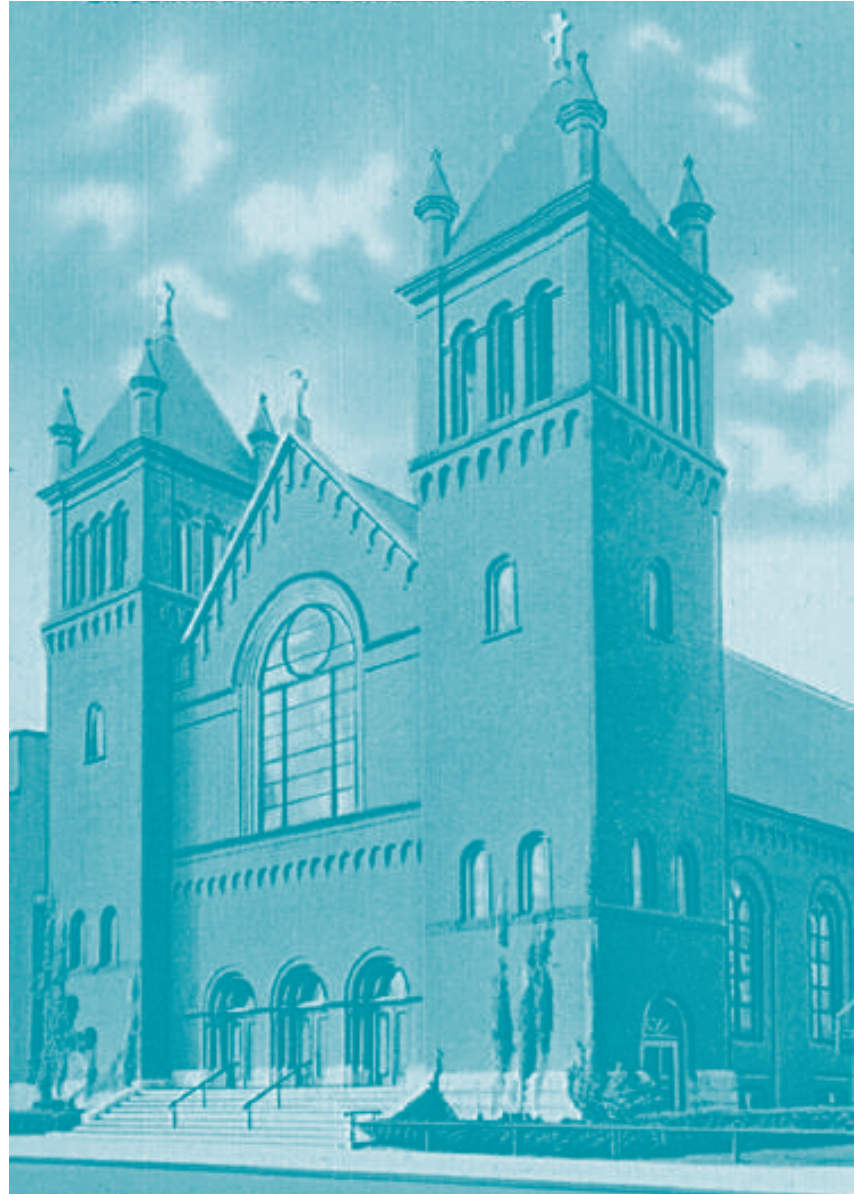

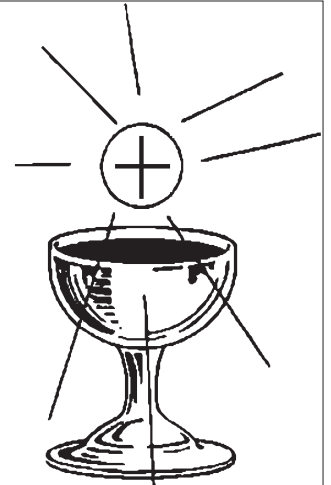

## *Consubstantial and other annoying changes*

Recently a parishioner asked why the Church changed some words of the Nicene Creed after using them for many years. Specifically, he mentioned the word “consubstantial.” Speaking of the Son, we now say “begotten not made, *consubstantial* with the Father.” We used to say, “one in *Being* with the Father.” Just when everyone knew the Nicene Creed by heart, suddenly we changed it. Even now, almost three years after the change, we still stumble over the “new” words. Why don’t “they” just leave things alone and stop these annoying changes? Good question!

Here’s why the Church made some changes in the English translations. For many centuries the Nicene Creed was said by the priest and altar servers or sung by the choir. This was done always in Latin. Hence, there was no *recited* English version of the Nicene Creed. Bilingual Missals had English translations, but these were never actually spoken at Mass. When the Church permitted Mass to be celebrated in English and other languages, we needed official translations in a hurry. The English version that we considered “old” and “traditional” was neither. It appeared less than 50 years ago, and it was produced very hastily.

Over the years, some bishops and theologians began to wonder about the accuracy of some parts of the translation. Please remember that the official forms of our ancient creeds exist *only* in Latin or Greek and contain terms that have no English equivalents. Because of this, there are frequent debates about how to express key Latin and Greek terms in contemporary English.

This brings us to “consubstantial.” Regarding the Son, the Latin states, “genitum, non factum, consubstantialem Patri.” In the old bilingual Missals, these words were rendered as “begotten, not made, one in *substance* with the Father.” The problem here, of course, is that most English-speaking people hear the word “substance” as “physical material,” which is *not* what it means in Latin. The version published in 1970 introduced the phrase “one in Being with the Father.” Though this pulled us away from the “materialistic” understanding of “substance,” some began to think that the Father and Son are absolutely identical as a single entity – a Being. This, unfortunately, obscured the distinction between Father and Son. The word “consubstantial,” though unfamiliar and not in common use, captures both the distinction between Father and Son while maintaining their shared “substance,” which refers to their Divinity.

At first glance, many will think this is all irrelevant mumbo-jumbo. But it isn’t. Though God is incomprehensible and no linguistic formulae can fully express the Truth about God, some formulations are much better than others. The revised texts of the Roman Missal are clearly superior to the “first draft” because they have restored many key terms and patterns of theological thought that we inadvertently lost in the Missal used for over 40 years. What seems to be “new” is really the recovery of the “old.”

This is a perfect example of a peculiar trend among Catholics. We quickly identify innovations as “tradition” if we like them. Saturday evening Masses of convenience, “take out” Holy Communion, and having the priest face the congregation are now regarded as unchangeable “traditions.” But they’re not at all. In fact, all these practices are less than 50 years old. Frequently, the “new changes,” which can unsettle people, simply restore – and protect – the genuine tradition.
