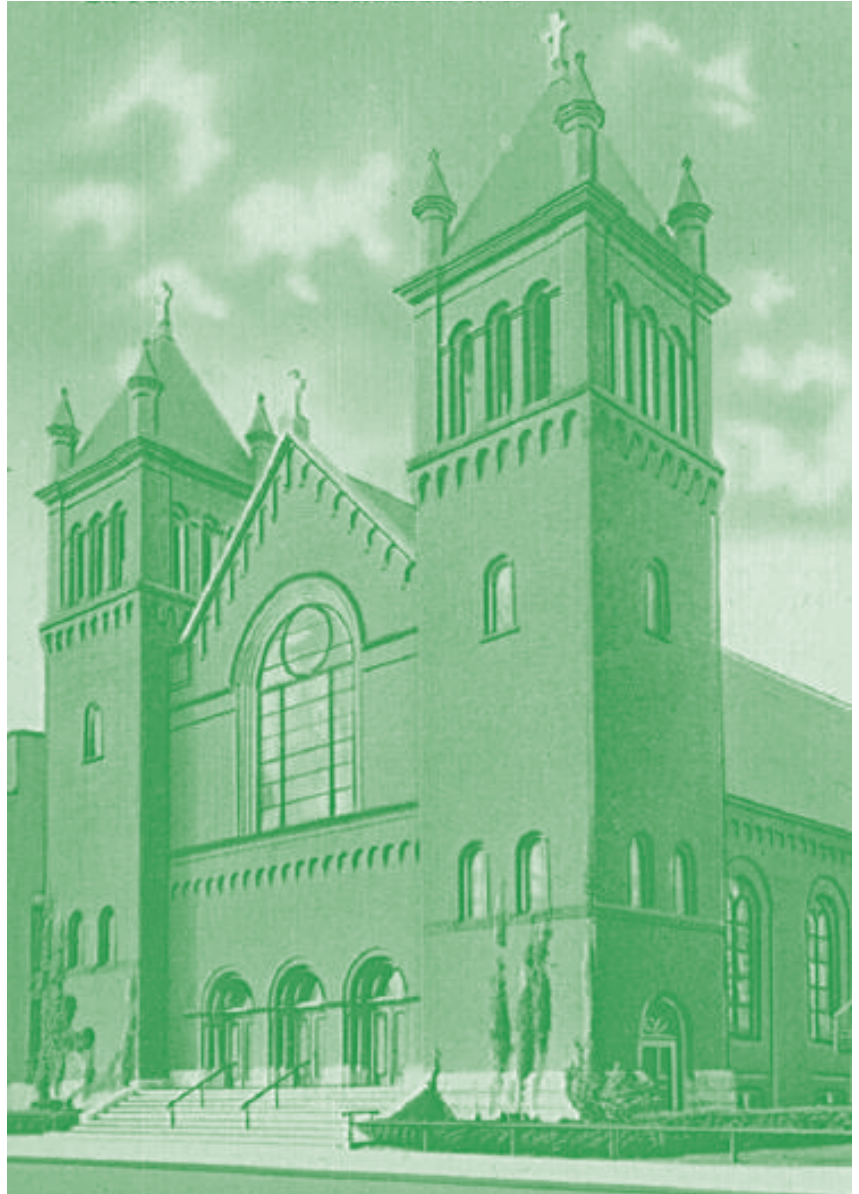

## *In praise of grandparents*

On Saturday, July 26, the Church will celebrate the memorial of St. Anne and St. Joachim, the maternal grandparents of Jesus. The gospels never mention either by name, however a small work called The Protoevangelium of James identifies them as Mary's parents, hence the grandparents of the Lord. Though we have no definitive historical information about the Lord's maternal grandparents, early Christians quickly assumed that they must have been saints because goodness flows from goodness. To put it another way, the supreme goodness of Jesus points *backwards* to his own mother and to her parents as well.

According to The Protoevangelium of James, Anne and Joachim were married for many years but remained childless, a great disgrace in that culture. The writer portrayed Joachim as a very righteous man who lavishly assisted the poor and generously supported the Temple. In response to the goodness and holiness of Joachim and Anne, God rewarded them with a child in old age. The child, of course, was Mary, who would become the mother of Jesus, Lord and Messiah.

Though the Church has never accepted The Protoevangelium of James as inspired Scripture, the story of Anne and Joachim gradually entered the liturgy. In the 6<sup>th</sup> century Emperor Justinian built a church in Constantinople – now Istanbul – to honor St. Anne, the grandmother of Jesus. During the Middle Ages St. Anne's popularity soared. In fact, Pope Gregory XV even made the feast of St. Anne a holy day of obligation in 1584. St. Joachim, by contrast, never came close to his wife's fame. In 1969, the Church abolished St. Joachim's individual feast day, which used to be on August 16, and combined his feast with his wife's. However, St. Anne has always greatly overshadowed her husband, whose memory almost expired.

No one knows for sure whether Jesus ever knew his maternal grandparents. If they were very old when Mary was born, as the traditional story asserts, it's very unlikely that either would have known Jesus as an adult. In any case, it's plausible that they could have known him as a child. Indeed, some artists produced paintings depicting St. Anne, the Blessed Mother, and the Child Jesus all together. (I've never seen any with poor St. Joachim, but perhaps they exist somewhere.) These paintings of Jesus, Mary, and St. Anne nicely depict the interweaving of "intergenerational" goodness: Grandmother, Mother, and Son/Grandson.

This interconnection of goodness among generations reminds us how important grandparents really are. Indeed, today many grandparents -- rather than the parents -- pass on the Catholic faith to children. Grandparents sometimes do this more effectively than parents because older people have the credibility of a lived *spiritual* approach to life. To young people, the faith of grandparents may appear more genuine because it's been tested in the fires of life. Almost 50 years ago, Fr. Pius Parsh, a meticulous German scholar of Catholic liturgy, made this point. In his elegant summary of the feast day liturgy of St. Anne, he inserted this uncharacteristic personal comment: "*A final thought. Let us think of our grandmothers today with gratitude.... Next to God we owe our faith principally to our mothers and grandmothers. To them we owe our gratitude.*" How true! As the Church recalls the memory of Christ's grandparents, we should remember ours as well. Those blessed with the vocation of being grandparents should never forget that their fervent prayers and good example do more to pass on the faith than perhaps anything else in the world.
