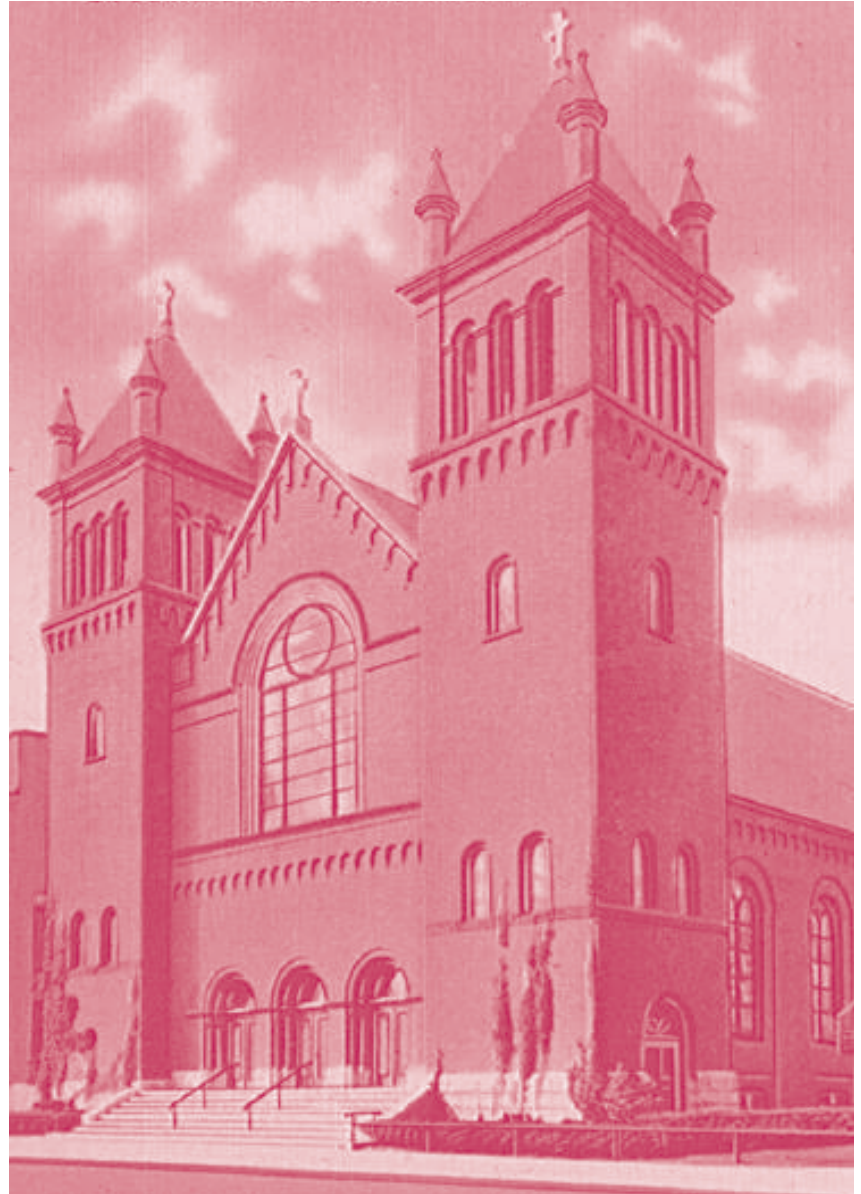

God as Trinity

In 1344 the Catholic Church designated the Sunday after Pentecost as the annual occasion to consider the doctrine of the Trinity. According to this central teaching there is only one true God, who is Father, Son, and Spirit, three distinct divine persons, yet only one God.

We tend to flee from this complex Mystery, thinking it's really irrelevant. After all, many ask, what difference does it make whether there is one god, five gods, three persons, six persons or no persons at all? Actually, it makes a huge difference: doctrine about God is also doctrine about human beings -- who and what we are. How we understand God powerfully affects how we understand ourselves.

If God is simply a "Higher Power," an impersonal energy field floating through outer space, then we are aliens to God and God is alien to us. But as Christians we do not worship such a "Higher Power." Rather, we worship the one true God, who is Father, Son, and Spirit; the One who exists beyond us, within us, and united to us. The doctrine of the Trinity teaches us that God and Humanity have a deep kinship; each is drawn toward the other.

Many biblical passages, including some from the Old Testament, portray this attraction. We see this beautifully expressed in Proverbs 8: 22-31, which is included among variety of readings used on Trinity Sunday. The speaker here is "Wisdom/Sophia," another name for the Son before becoming the human being we call Jesus Christ. Wisdom/Sophia says:

*Then was I beside him as his craftsman, and I was his delight day by day,
playing before him all the while, playing on the surface of his earth,
and I found delight in the human race.*

Notice two things here.

First, the text uses the word "playing" to describe the relationship between God and Wisdom/Word/Christ. We don't often imagine the Divine as "playful," yet here we see Wisdom/Word/Christ as carefree and joyful, leaping, running, frolicking across the vast expanse of the universe. We tend to think of God as old; yet though God is ancient, God is also eternally young, for God has no beginning and no end.

Second, and even more important, Wisdom/Word/Christ declares: *I found delight in the human race*. The literal translation is: *I found delight with the children of men*. God seeks out human beings -- children -- as "playmates." Here God's choice of human beings reveals us back to ourselves. We discover that something deep within us, namely God's own "image and likeness," attracts Wisdom/Sophia/Christ, who delights in us. How amazing to know that God gazes on each of us and sees something delightful.

As we praise the Most Blessed Trinity, the One God, who is always Father, Son, and Spirit, we rejoice to know that God forever delights in us as His cherished "playmates," children fashioned by His own hands.
