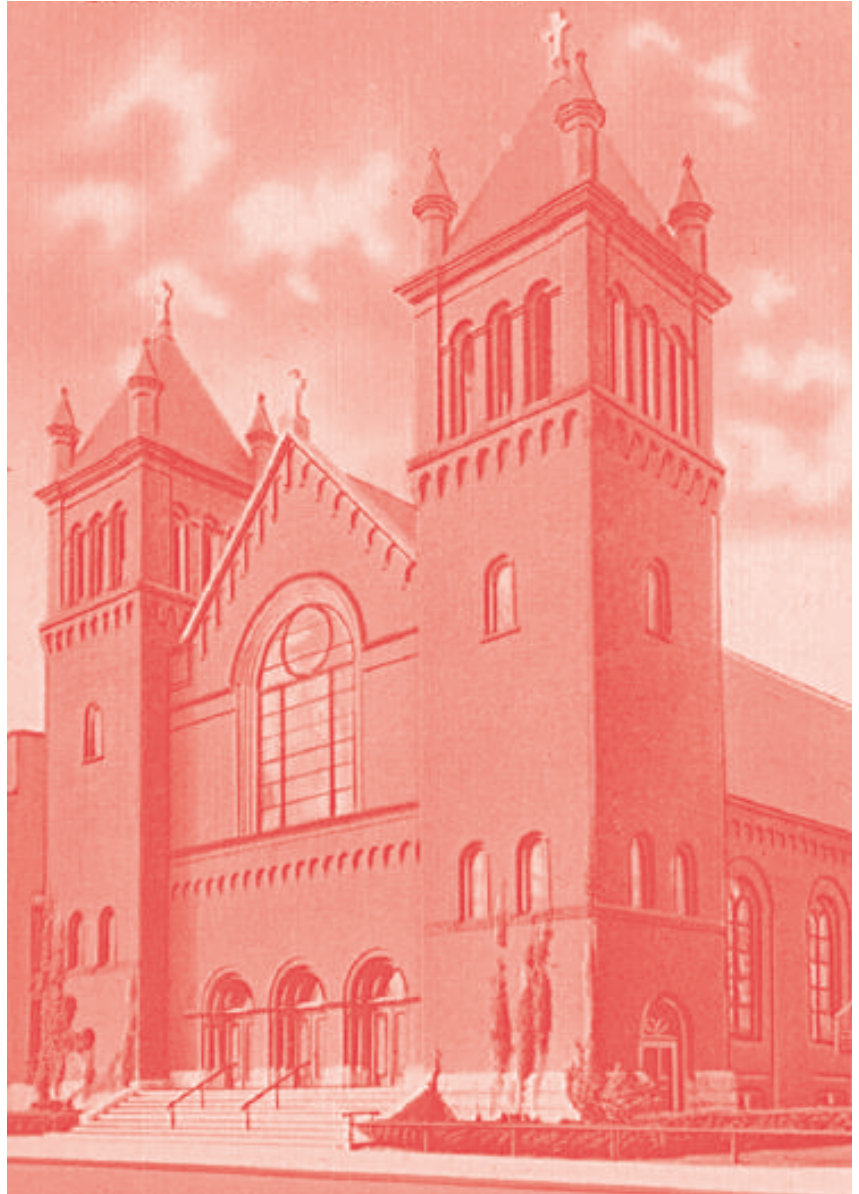

The Holy Spirit as Finger

On Pentecost the Church directs our gaze toward the Holy Spirit, the Divine Person who usually evades our attention. Unlike the Father and Son, whom we easily visualize, the Holy Spirit is very difficult to portray. In light of this, the Church has used many images to express the work and "personality" of the Holy Spirit. Generally, we know only two: the dove and fire. The ancient Latin hymn *Veni Creator Spiritus*, which goes back to the 9th century, offers additional images: fragrant anointing, spring of water, and defense attorney, which translates the word *Paraclete*. It also uses a very strange image: *Digitus paternae dexteræ*, which means "finger of the right hand of the Father." How can the Holy Spirit be a finger?

This term actually comes from Sacred Scripture. It refers to the Holy Spirit as a gentle yet powerful expression of Divine activity. In the gospels, we find the "finger" in Luke 11:14-22, the confrontation between Jesus and his enemies who accuse Him of being in league with the devil. He responds to the charge by saying, "But if it is through the finger of God that I drive out devils, then the Kingdom of God has indeed caught you unawares" (Luke 11:20). Here Jesus indicates that He does not operate independently but in cooperation with the Father and Holy Spirit, the "finger," which delicately touches the possessed person and destroys the satanic power. The "finger" is so small, yet always effective.

Two "finger" passages from the Old Testament are especially important. The first is Deuteronomy 9:10. Here Moses says, "The Lord gave me two stone tablets inscribed by the finger of God." Though Moses obviously did not have the Christian language to express clearly God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, in this passage he shows that the act of handing on the Commandments was somehow "collective" in that "Someone" -- known to us as the Holy Spirit -- did the writing. This shows that the Holy Spirit acts as the Divine communicator, leading people to a clearer understanding of God's ways by "writing" down the mysterious commands in an intelligible form.

The second passage is Exodus 8:19. Here the magicians employed by the Pharaoh witness the various plagues brought about when Moses was demanding freedom for his people. The magicians then tell the Pharaoh, "This is the finger of God," meaning that they correctly perceived the Holy Spirit's action on behalf of Israel.

Note also that the "finger" is specified as being on the *right hand* of God. In Hebrew biblical imagery, power and goodness are always identified with the right hand while evil is done with the left hand. Hence, the Holy Spirit, who is God, only does good deeds.

This unusual image of the Holy Spirit as *finger of God* expresses very beautifully the almost hidden involvement of the Spirit in our lives. A person's finger is a very tiny part of his or her body, yet through the finger one can give direction, warning, and comfort. The Holy Spirit is the same, always tapping us ever so slightly, always assuring us of the Divine Presence.
