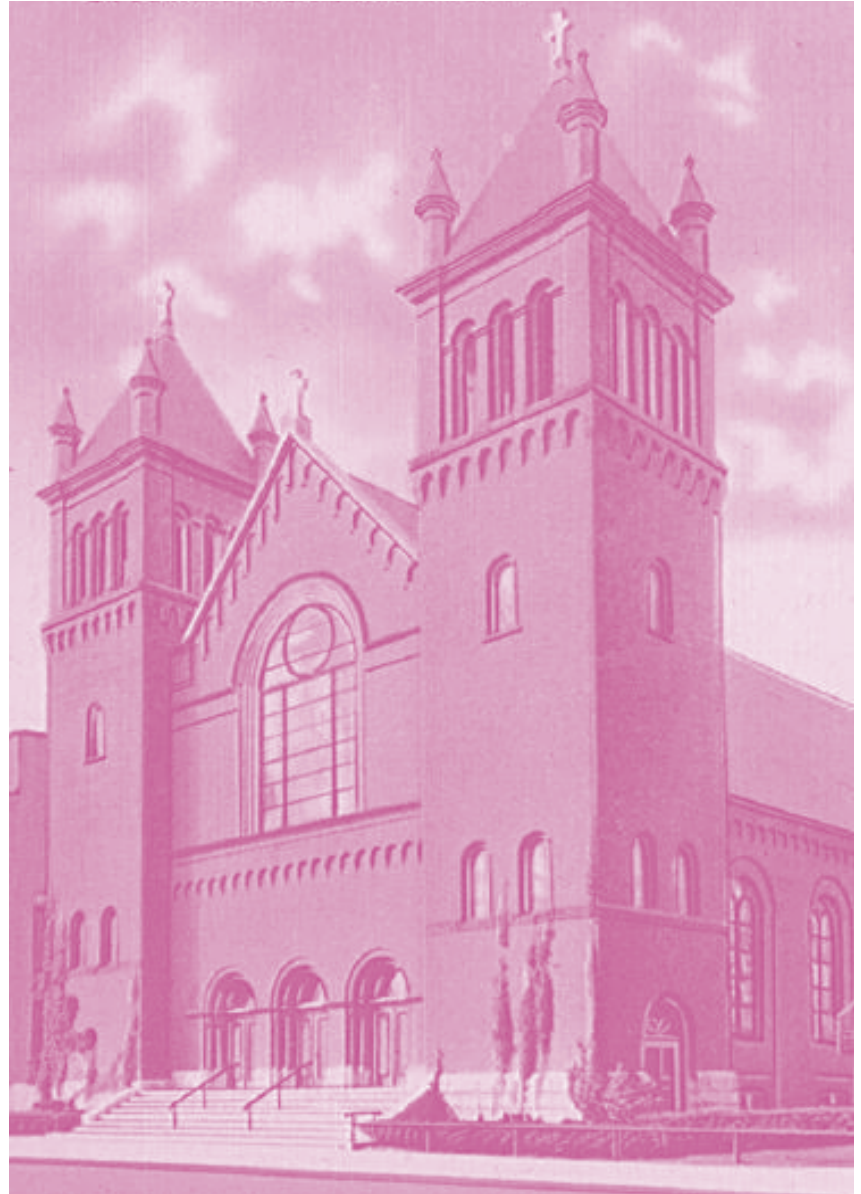

Church Gossip: Why We Love It

On many occasions, Pope Francis has warned against the habit of spreading gossip within the Church, whether at the highest or lowest levels. In his Angelus message of February 16, the Holy Father said: “It’s so rotten, gossip. At the beginning, it seems to be something enjoyable and fun, like a piece of candy. But at the end, it fills the heart with bitterness and also poisons us.” Still, we do it. And enjoy it. Why?

First, those who spread rumors – “inside information” – appear to have power. After all, they seem to know “what’s really going on in the Church.” In most cases, their “news” is completely wrong or twisted to advance their own ideas about what should be happening.

Second, gossip undermines legitimate authority. Let’s face it: Most people don’t want any authority over them, whether from the state or Church. One clever way to free oneself from authority is to cut it down to size, especially through “news” of incompetence, impending failure, or even immoral behavior. In cases like this, the authority is not directly rejected, but those who hold it are.

Third, many who spread gossip need to diminish other people in order to elevate themselves. They magnify their own wisdom or competence by demonstrating that other people are stupid or incompetent. Hence, gossips rejoice when things run amok. “See,” they say, “I told you that they were wrong. Look at the mess they’re making now.”

Gossip, of course, has always afflicted God’s people. Remember how Miriam murmured against Moses, her own brother, when he took a black wife. And recall how the apostles gossiped among themselves about “who is the greatest.” (They even gossiped at the Last Supper!)

Internal church gossip is worse than other forms because it violates the spiritual bond of Baptism. We discover this by examining the origin of the word “gossip.” According to The Oxford English Dictionary, “gossip” is the contemporary form of the old English word “godsib,” which meant “godparent.” The dictionary defines “gossip” this way: “one who has contracted spiritual affinity with another by acting as a sponsor at baptism.” A “godsib,” then, had intimate knowledge about his or her godchild. Hence, anything said by the “godsib” about the godchild, whether good or bad, had instant credibility. Gradually, “godsib” became “gossip.” It then came to refer to a person who spreads malicious rumors and news about other people.

Perhaps a return to “godsib” – the word that signifies a bonded relationship of baptized persons in love and mutual respect – would do much to advance the Pope’s desire for a “gossip-free” Church.
