The National Pilgrim Virgin of the USA At St. Patrick & St. Christopher Churches

On Tuesday, June 10th The National Pilgrim Virgin Statue of the USA will be at St. Patrick during the noon Mass. This beautiful image of Our Lady of Fatima was blessed by Pope Paul VI and presented to the United States by bishop Venancio (of Fatima) in 1967 to carry the message of Fatima to our country. *There will be a rosary and a talk after the Mass. Light refreshments will be served in the center afterwards.*

St. Christopher Parish, 62 Manchester Street, Nashua also *is participating in the statue tour from 5pm through 8pm.* During this time you are invited to come see and venerate before this beautiful Statue of Our Lady of Fatima. Magnificat

May, often considered "Mary's Month," concludes with the Feast of the Visitation on May 31. This is the only universal Marian feast observed during May. Her solemnities -- the highest type of feast -- occur on January 1, August 15, and December 8.

The Feast of the Visitation originated with the Franciscans during the first half of the 13th century. It became a universal feast in 1389 and was originally placed on July 2. When the Roman Calendar was revised in the late 1960's the Visitation was moved to May 31, replacing the Queenship of Mary, which in turn was shifted to August 22, one week after the Assumption.

This sole Marian feast of May commemorates the encounter between *Mary*, pregnant with Jesus, and *Elizabeth*, pregnant with John the Baptist. Luke's account of the event (cf. Luke 1:39-56) shows Mary engaged in a generous work of service, namely the care of her older relative who was to give birth to an unexpected child. This event is also important because it contains one of the principal prayers of the Church, the Canticle of Mary, more commonly called the *Magnificat* (cf. Luke 2:46-55)

Within the Liturgy of the Hours, also known as the Divine Office, the Magnificat acts as the centerpiece of Evening Prayer, also called Vespers. The Magnificat has been part of the Church's daily prayer since the 4th century; and one scholarly tradition asserts that St. Benedict, who did much to shape the Divine Office, placed the Magnificat within Vespers. This triumphal prayer of Mary was permanently situated in the Evening Office so that Mary's voice would be joined forever with the praying voices of the whole Church everyday.

Through the Magnificat, Mary -- in union with the whole Church -- expresses two principal truths. First, she humbly acknowledges that the greatness that adheres to her is not *self-created* but the act of God. Mary sings, "*For the Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is God's Name*" (Luke 2:49). This is not bragging but humble recognition of God as the source of all blessings.

Second, Mary's Magnificat is a prophetic statement about the ultimate outcome of God's involvement with human history. Living as she did as a poor woman in country dominated by imperial Rome, her words boldly prophesy the reversal of the *status quo*. Indeed, the prayer is tinged with a hint of genuine revolution. "God," she declares, "has brought down the powerful from their thrones, and lifted up the lowly; God has filled the hungry with good thing and sent the rich way empty" (Luke 2:52-53). Mary's prayer envisions the ultimate reversal of fortunes.

The whole Church sings the Magnificat with Mary every evening because it brims over with joyful hope and expectation that God indeed will fulfill all the divine promises, even as we prepare to sleep. It reminds us that God's gentle work continues even without us.
